Reporting to the Pipe fitter Supervisor, Pipe fitters will be required to lie out, assemble, fabricate, maintain and repair piping systems carrying water, steam, chemicals and fuel in heating, cooling, lubricating and other process piping systems associated with new vessel construction, industrial and repair contract.

- Read and interpret drawings and specifications to determine layout requirements.
- Cut openings for pipe in walls, floors and ceilings using hand or power tools or machines.
- Select type and size of pipe required.

- Measure, cut, thread and bend pipe to required shape using hand and power tools.
- Tack weld, braze, cement, solder and thread joints to join pipes and fabricate sections of piping systems.
- Operate manual or semi-automatic cutting equipment.
- Test system for leaks using testing equipment.
- Clean and maintain pipe units and fittings.
- Remove and replace worn components.
- Maintain good housekeeping practices in the workplace.
- Work safely in accordance with company safety policies and procedures.
- Perform other duties as assigned by Pipe fitter Supervisor. In addition to the Educational Requirements: A minimum of 2 years related experience in an industrial environment. The equivalent of 72 months direct experience in this discipline is required for qualification of certification exam by the Alberta Apprenticeship Board.
